By an order dated 6 July 2022 made in the matter of EMIS Group plc (the "Company"), the Court has granted permission for a meeting of the Scheme Shareholders (as defined in the scheme document of the Company dated 8 July 2022 (the "Scheme Document")) to be convened for the purpose of considering and, if thought fit, approving (with or without modification) a scheme of arrangement pursuant to Part 26 of the Companies Act 2006 (as amended) (the "Scheme") between the Company and the Scheme Shareholders (as defined in the Scheme Document), such court meeting to be held at 11.00 a.m. (London time) on 9 August 2022 at the Company's registered office at Fulford Grange, Micklefield Lane, Rawdon, Leeds, England LS19 6BA (the "Court Meeting").

Notes to Form of Proxy

1. Terms defined in the Company's scheme circular dated 8 July 2022 (the "**Scheme Document**") shall apply equally in this Form of Proxy, unless the context otherwise requires. Full details of the resolution to be proposed at the Court Meeting, together with explanatory notes, are set out in the Notice of Court Meeting contained in Part 9 of the Scheme Document. Before completing this Form of Proxy, please also read the section entitled "Action to be Taken" set out on the opening pages of the Scheme Document. 2. The Court has appointed Patrick De Smedt, or, failing him, Andrew Thorburn or, failing him, any other director of the Company (each with a business address of Fulford Grange, Micklefield Lane, Rawdon, Leeds, England LS19 6BA) to act as Chair of the Court Meeting and has directed the Chair to report the result thereof to the Court.
3. Every Scheme Shareholder has the right to appoint some other person(s) of their choice, who need not be a shareholder, as his or her proxy to exercise all or any of his or her rights to attend, submit questions and, on a poll, to vote on their behalf at the Court Meeting. Scheme Shareholders are strongly encouraged to submit proxy appointments and instructions for the Court Meeting as soon as possible, using any of the methods (by post, online or electronically through CREST) set out below. Scheme Shareholders are also strongly encouraged to appoint the Chair of the Court Meeting as their proxy by leaving the 'name of proxy' box blank. This should be done as soon as possible and at least 48 hours (excluding any part of such 48-hour period falling on a non-working day) before the Court Meeting. If you wish to appoint a person other than the Chair, please insert the name of your chosen proxy holder in the space provided (see reverse). If the proxy is being appointed in relation to less than your full voting entitlement, please enter in the box next to the proxy holder's name (see reverse) the number of Scheme Shares in relation to which they are authorised to act as your proxy. Unless otherwise instructed, a person appointed as proxy will exercise his or her discretion as to any business other than the resolution to approve the Scheme (including amendments to the Scheme and any procedural business, including any resolution to adjourn) which may come before the Court Meeting.
4. Entitlement to attend and vote at the Court Meeting or any adjournment thereof and the number of votes which may be cast at the Court Meeting will be determined by reference to the register of members of the Company at 6.30 p.m. (London time) on 5 August 2022 or, if the Court Meeting is adjourned, 6.30 p.m. (London time) on the date which is two days before the date set for the adjourned Court Meeting (excluding any non-working day). Changes to the register of members after the relevant time shall be disregarded in determining the rights of any person to attend and vote at the Court Meeting.
5. It is requested that this Form of Proxy (together with any power of attorney or other authority, if any, under which it is signed, or a duly certified copy thereof) be returned to Link Group at Central Square, 29 Wellington Street, Leeds LS1 4DL, either: (i) by post or (ii) (during normal business hours only) by hand, so as to be received as soon as possible and in any event not later than 11.00 a.m. (London time) on 5 August 2022 (or, in the case of an adjournment of the Court Meeting, not less than 48 hours (excluding any part of such 48-hour period falling on a non-working day) before the time and date appointed for the adjourned Court Meeting). If this Form of Proxy is not lodged by this time it can be handed to the Chair of the Court Meeting or to Link Group, on behalf of the Chair of the Court Meeting, before the commencement of the Court Meeting and will be valid.
6. To appoint more than one proxy, an additional proxy form(s) may be obtained by contacting the Link Group shareholder helpline using the details set out in Note 16 below or you may photocopy this Form of Proxy. Please indicate in the box next to the proxy holder's name (see reverse) the number of Scheme Shares in relation to which they are authorised to act as your proxy. Please also indicate by marking the box provided if the proxy instruction is one of multiple instructions being given. All forms must be signed and should be returned together in the same envelope.
7. Scheme Shareholders who hold their Scheme Shares in uncertificated form through CREST who wish to appoint a proxy or proxies through the CREST electronic proxy appointment service may do so for the purpose of this Court Meeting and any adjournment(s) of it by using the procedures described in the CREST Manual (which can be viewed at www.euroclear.com). In accordance with Regulation 41 of the Uncertificated Securities Regulations 2001 (the "**CREST Regulations**"), only those members entered on the relevant register of members of the Company at 6.30 p.m. on 5 August 2022, being the date which is two days before the Court Meeting or, in the event that the Court Meeting is adjourned, in the register of members of the Company at 6.30 p.m. on the date which is two days before the adjourned Court Meeting (in each case, excluding any non-working day), shall be entitled to attend and vote at the Court Meeting in respect of the number of Scheme Shares registered in their name at that time. Changes to entries on the relevant register of members after the relevant time shall be disregarded in determining the rights of any person to attend and vote at the Court Meeting or any adjourned Court Meeting. Scheme Shareholders who hold their Scheme Shares in the Company through CREST ("**CREST members**") and who wish to appoint a proxy or proxies through the CREST electronic proxy appointment service may do so for the purpose of this Court Meeting and any adjournment(s) of it by using the procedures described in the CREST Manual. CREST personal members or other CREST sponsored members, and those CREST members who have appointed a service provider(s), should refer to their CREST sponsor or voting service provider(s), who will be able to take the appropriate action on their behalf.
8. In order for a proxy appointment or instruction made using the CREST service to be valid, the appropriate CREST message (a "**CREST Proxy Instruction**") must be properly authenticated in accordance with the specifications of Euroclear and must contain the information required for such instructions as described in the CREST Manual. The message (regardless of whether it constitutes the appointment of a proxy or an amendment to the instructions given to a previously appointed proxy) must, in order to be valid, be transmitted so as to be received by Link Group (CREST Participant ID RA10) not later than 48 hours (excluding any part of such 48-hour period falling on a non-working day) before the time appointed for the Court Meeting (or adjourned Court Meeting) as applicable. For this purpose, the time of receipt will be taken to be the time (as determined by the timestamp applied to the message by the CREST Applications Host) from which Link Group are able to retrieve the message by enquiry to CREST in the manner prescribed by CREST.
9. CREST members and, where applicable, their CREST sponsors or voting service providers should note that Euroclear does not make available special procedures in CREST for any particular messages. Normal system timings and limitations will therefore apply in relation to the input of CREST Proxy Instructions. It is the responsibility of the CREST member concerned to take (or, if the CREST member is a CREST personal member or sponsored member or has appointed any voting service provider(s), to procure that his/her CREST sponsor or voting service provider(s) take(s)) such action as shall be necessary to ensure that a message is transmitted by means of the CREST system by any particular time. For further information on the logistics of submitting messages in CREST, CREST members and, where applicable, their CREST sponsors or voting service providers are referred, in particular, to those sections of the CREST Manual concerning practical limitations of the CREST system and timings. The Company may treat as invalid a CREST Proxy Instruction in the circumstances set out in Regulation 35(5)(a) of the CREST Regulations.
10. As an alternative to completing and returning the printed BLUE Form of Proxy or appointing a proxy through CREST, Scheme Shareholders entitled to attend and vote at the Court Meeting may appoint a proxy electronically by logging on to the following website: www.signalshares.com or registering if you have not previously done so. To register, you will need your Investor Code (IVC) which is printed on the front of this Form of Proxy or is available from Link Group. For an electronic proxy appointment to be valid, the appointment must be received by Link Group no later than 11.00 a.m. on 5 August 2022 (or, in the case of an adjournment of the Court Meeting, not less than 48 hours (excluding any part of such 48-hour period falling on a non-working day) before the time and date set for the adjourned Court Meeting). Full details of the procedure to be followed to appoint a proxy electronically are given on the website.
11. Any alterations made to this Form of Proxy should be initialled.
12. The completion and return of this Form of Proxy (or transmission of a proxy appointment or voting instruction electronically through CREST, by post or by any other procedure described in the Scheme Document) will not prevent you from attending, submitting questions and/or any objections and voting at the Court Meeting in person if you are entitled to and wish to do so.
13. In the case of joint holders of Scheme Shares, the vote of the senior who tenders a vote, whether remotely or by proxy, will be accepted to the exclusion of the vote(s) of the other joint holder(s). For this purpose, seniority will be determined by the order in which the names stand in the register of members of the Company in respect of the joint holding.
14. As an alternative to appointing a proxy, any holder of Scheme Shares which is a corporation may appoint one or more corporate representatives who may exercise on its behalf all its powers as a member, provided that if two or more corporate representatives purport to vote in respect of the same Scheme Shares, if they purport to exercise the power in the same way as each other, the power is treated as exercised in that way, and in other cases the power is treated as not exercised.
15. You may not use any electronic address provided either in the Notice of Court Meeting in Part 9 of the Scheme Document or in any related documents (including this Form of Proxy) to communicate with the Company for any reason other than those expressly stated.
16.
